\$21,623.75 to the Cambridge Valley Rescue Squad for paramedic tuition, funding of a Health, Wellness & Safety Program for employees, and partial purchase of a Power Stretcher.

\$21,595.96 to the Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation at Hoosick Falls to purchase a bladder scanner, wheelchair scale, Broda Chair and a Suzy Q Food Delivery System.

\$20,000 to the Easton-Greenwich Rescue Squad to partially support the purchase of a new ambulance.

\$20,000 to the Glens Falls Hospital for recruitment and retention of a newly hired doctor in the Greenwich Regional Medical Center.

\$45,551.25 to the Glens Falls Hospital for the purchase of (9) High-low Power Exam Tables to be used in the Cambridge Family Health Center, Greenwich Regional Medical Center, Hoosick Falls Family Health Center and Salem Family Health Center.

\$8,200 to the Warren-Washington Association for Mental Health to fund e-prescribing for the Caleo Counselling Services.

\$11,000 to the Retired & Senior Volunteer Program of Warren and Washington Counties (RSVP). The purpose of the funds is to partially support the medical transportation program in Southern Washington County.
